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### 2. COMPOSITION/INFORMATION ON INGREDIENTS:

COMPOSITION COMMENTS:	Contains mixture of cineole (eucalyptol) @ ~70% and other terpenes.

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### 3. HAZARDS IDENTIFICATION:

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Flammable. Harmful: may cause lung damage if swallowed.

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### 4. FIRST AID MEASURES:

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GENERAL:	IN ALL CASES OF DOUBT OR WHEN SYMPTOMS PERSIST, ALWAYS SEEK MEDICAL ATTENTION
INHALATION:	Move affected person to fresh air. If recovery not rapid, seek medical attention.
