1. Chemical Identification

Common Name: Sensi-Temp® Resin Temporary Cement - base

Ref #: 70010

2. Composition/Information on Ingredients

Preparation of bis-GMA, multifunctional methacrylates, polymerization activator.

3. Hazards Identification

Acute Toxicity: May cause eye, respiratory and skin irritation in high concentrations.

Chronic Toxicity: A very small number of individuals may develop contact dermatitis upon prolonged and chronic exposure.

4. First Aid Measures

Eye Contact: Flush with large quantities of water for 15 minutes and consult a physician.

Skin Contact: Wash with soap and water.

Inhalation: If irritation occurs, take victim to open air. If breathing difficulty persists, consult a physician.

Ingestion: Consult a physician.

5. Fire Fighting Measures

Flash Point and Method: N/A

Extinguishing Media: Carbon dioxide, water spray, dry chemical.

6. Accidental Release Measures

Environmental Precautions: Avoid seepage into sewers and water supplies.

Clean-up procedure: Contain spill and pick up material with a suitable absorbent material. Place absorbent into a container for later disposal. Clean spill area with detergent and water.

Handling: No special measures necessary if handled according to instructions.

Storage: Keep container tightly closed when not in use. Store in a cool, dry location. Keep material in original packaging.

Exposure Limit Method: Use only in well ventilated areas.
