SDS Exemption

XyliMelts is exempted from government SDS requirements for reasons stated below. However, some customers want an SDS anyway.

The Hazard Communication Standard (Subpart Z, Toxic and Hazardous Substances, 29 CFR 1910.1200) exempts consumer products that are used in the same manner (e.g., with the same frequency and duration of use) as a normal consumer would use it. Employees of OraHealth customers use the OraCoat products only as consumers, if at all.

The HCS standard requires that "the employer shall maintain . . . copies of the required SDSs for each *hazardous chemical*". **XyliMelts** includes no hazardous chemicals. All of the ingredients are food ingredients that may be consumed without risk.
